I would like to congratulate all our year 11 students on their GCSE results this summer. Staff have worked extremely hard in preparing students for the next stage of these new qualifications. With the more challenging content and different assessment regime, students have responded extremely well and I could not be prouder of their achievements.

83% of Year 11 students have achieved a level 4+ in English with 64% achieving a 5+. 74% achieved a 4+ in Maths.

Overall the College achieved over 5% of the new top grade of a 9.
