

## 16-19 Catch up Premium – September 2021 update

The 16-19 Tuition Fund has been extended for a further two years, into the 2023/24 academic year. The fund will continue to provide targeted small group tuition in English, mathematics and other subjects where learning has been disrupted because of the pandemic and is available to all 16-19 providers.

As part of this funding, Sir Harry Smith Community College, Sixth Form received £4,427 to enable us to provide support programmes and enable them to reach those most in need.
