As many of you will be purchasing uniform ready for September, I would like to remind you of the expectations surrounding footwear.

Acceptable Shoe styles for school

Plain black leather shoes [or unbranded inexpensive plain black plimsolls] with flat heels should be worn. N.B. Shoes must be exclusively black i.e. no patches of other colours and, as shoes, they must be below the ankle.



Unacceptable Shoe styles for school

Nothing made by a sports manufacturer or in a sporty style e.g. leather trainers, Vans, Reebok, Converse, Nike etc. (regardless of colour) or trainer style shoes displaying their logo [even in black], boots of any description, and backless shoes.



If you have any further questions, please do not hesitate to contact your child's Tutor or Year Leader. If you are unsure whether footwear is acceptable, please consult the College before purchasing.

PE Uniform

From September, for all new Year 7 students, we have introduced a unisex, plain black ¼ zip sports top. This is an optional item to be worn outside during colder weather PE lessons. Please note that this is not compulsory for Years 8-11 and only needs to be purchased when your child outgrows their current jumper/rugby shirt.
